



Fisheries Management

The **Fisheries Management** course examines international principles for sustainable fisheries management, ecological aspects of fisheries, fisheries economics, fisheries data collection and analysis, and fisheries and coastal resource management. It looks into the application of international fisheries management principles and measures in a number of national jurisdictions. The course also discusses management frameworks established by regional fisheries organisations and the challenges confronting member States in implementing such frameworks.
